CONTEXT:

ROLE:

The role of the Associate Campus Minister (ACM) is to be an on-site Leader at our future campus. This position assists in the implementation of mission, vision, values, and strategy set forth by the leadership team. Working closely with the Campus Pastor, the ACM will work to implement a sustainable campus in O'Fallon, Illinois.

PRE-REQUISITES:

- Have a relationship with Christ that is evident by a daily walk and displays a life of character, spiritual maturity and wisdom, setting an example for staff, congregants, and the community(s) we serve.
- Demonstrate a strong work ethic and leadership ability, leading by example in recruiting and developing effective leaders and volunteers for the work of ministry and building up the body of Christ.
- Fully aligned with the mission, vision, and values of Cornerstone Christian Church and its leadership
- Complete work timely and with a spirit of excellence, while requiring little to no supervision.
- Ability to manage, lead, mentor, and develop teams through relationships and a pastoral heart.
- Flexible, process-oriented, supportive team player that is also a self-starter.

REQUIREMENTS:

- Become a member of Cornerstone Christian Church
- A Bible college degree from a Restoration Movement college/university or equivalent ministry experience
- A minimum of 5 years ministry experience





RESPONSIBILITIES:

Campus Development

The Associate Campus Minister will work in conjunction with the Campus Pastor to ensure the spiritual development and logistical execution at Cornerstone Christian Church - O'Fallon. This will include assisting in the process and strategy of launching the campus; developing a plan with Stadia; and working with Operations, Adult Ministries, and Creative Arts to keep aligned with Cornerstone's vision, mission and values. Further responsibilities include recruiting, training, equipping, and empowering relationships with launch team/volunteers and be a constant pastoral presence for weekend service attenders to enhance possibility of connecting people to service.

Creative Arts

The O'Fallon campus needs the Associate Campus Minister to lead worship while empowering other worship leaders and musicians, constantly evaluating and adjusting worship culture, recruiting and coordinating training Worship Arts and Tech Arts volunteers, and ensuring that stories are captured and told.

Community Outreach

The Associate Campus Minister will coordinate, recruit, and implement local outreach by networking with the community and volunteers while coordinating community outreach events (as needed). This results in reaching various communities and discovering various communities and discovering the unmet needs of our community.

Associate Pastor Duties

From time to time duties will arise that are not part of the daily work, but are part of the job as a pastor of Cornerstone Christian Church. These responsibilities, while infrequent are very important to the ministry of Cornerstone and as such need to be fulfilled with great urgency. These include being a voice for communication, fulfilling pastoral needs as necessary, and responding to e-mails and other requests in a timely fashion.
